Cordon Negro Brut, Freixenet, Spain split **\$6.00** **\$24.00**

Crisp, clean and well balanced; the dosage is very dry, but the acidity is lower than most champagnes for a softer, smoother flavor. It is medium-bodied with a moderately long and clean finish.

Asti Spumante, Martini & Rossi, Italy split **\$7.00** **\$26.00**

Fresh, light and sweet fruit make this a perfect celebration wine.

Pinot Noir, Mark West, CA

Pinot Noir, Merryvale Starmont, Napa, CA **\$54.00**

This wine exhibits varietal characteristics of fresh cherry and strawberry along with spice, toast, and vanilla.

Merlot, Blackstone, CA
